Jesus: "I want this. Do you know how much my Father loves Mary? See her deep love for Him through her love for me at the foot of the cross. I call you not to just 'imitate' her in this but to 'unite spiritually' with her heart – at the foot of the cross – your whole heart with her heart and maternal embrace there – because that is her role in bringing forth the fruit my Father wants: the salvation of souls."

Mary: "To be prayed three times in the day specifically for one person, while remaining in 'physical' contact with this person as well. Morning and night, if physically possible, kneel as praying, and pray at these times in a private place. In the afternoon, since you are in the middle of daily duties, just pray in and from your heart."

**PRAYER OF INTERCESSION AND
CONSOLATION FOR THE
SALVATION OF SOULS**

Intercession

O Most Compassionate Mother Mary kneeling at the foot of the Cross of your Son, Jesus, you constantly seek to intercede for and to console your suffering children.

I kneel with you here, my Blessed Mother, and spiritually unite to your Immaculate Heart my heart in intercession for _____
in his (*her*) (physical, emotional, and/
or spiritual) sufferings as he (*she*)

clings to Jesus on His Cross so that He may redeem his (*her*) suffering for the salvation of souls in accordance with the Will of the Father.

(remain within her Immaculate Heart for a while in intercession)

Consolation

My Mother, Most Compassionate, I give you my heart for _____. Your Sorrowful Heart knows all his (*her*) sufferings. Let me enter into his (*her*) sufferings through your Sorrowful Heart so that I may not be crushed.

*(Take time to truly enter into his (*her*) sufferings as you know them. You are not doing this to take on his (*her*) sufferings so that he (*she*) no longer experiences them. You embrace his (*her*) sufferings in union with our Blessed Mother's Sorrowful Heart. In time, she will allow you to understand and to embrace the sufferings more deeply, which makes you better able to listen and to speak to this person.)*

My Blessed Mother, you desire to make me an instrument of your consolation, therefore consume my heart by your Most Compassionate Heart so that all consolation may come from you.

(Fully allow her Most Compassionate Heart to consume your heart and direct it in her consolation)

I make this prayer through your Immaculate Heart and your Son's Most Sacred Heart. Amen.

**“OUR MOST COMPASSIONATE

MEDITATION IN THE IMAGE**

Mary: “This is so important to do at least once a day – where words become more internal and spontaneous as the spiritual union grows – not just recitation but ‘living in’ this image– being fully ‘present’ in this spiritual union makes you better equipped to be present to this person in his (*her*) suffering and to bring our presence to him (*her*).”

“My child, see me kneeling at the foot of the cross. Kneel with me. See my tears of sorrow for this person in his (*her*) suffering. Bring me your tears for him (*her*) too. See in my eyes how I yearn for this person to cling to my Son in all he (*she*) is suffering. Kneel with me in prayer for this person. Let us intercede on his (*her*) behalf together in total spiritual union of heart, in the eternal heart of the Father.

My child, gaze up with me into my Son’s face. Beyond the tears and blood, see in His eyes the love and mercy pouring forth into the eyes of this person clinging to Him. See in His gaze the soft look of gratitude to this person and to us for bringing this

suffering to Him – not to be taken away or ended – but redeemed to save souls.

My child, see the subtle smile on my face and on my Son’s face that reflect the delight of the Father because His eternal design is fulfilled by Jesus’ suffering, death and resurrection. The tool of Satan is destroyed as the suffering is brought to Jesus’ cross, and the Father uses it to save souls. Smile with us, even in the tears, because your intercession and spiritual union in this devotion pleases the Father.

My child, see on my arms and hands the blood and dirt of my Son as I sought to console Him. You do not shrink from reaching out, and you desire to console this person clinging to my Son on the Cross. Bring that desire into my embrace; reach out your arms with mine as we unite spiritually to console this person in the Father’s eternal embrace of love.

My child, intercede and console with me in complete spiritual union. Let us keep our eyes fixed upon the eyes of Jesus, where we see the eternal love revealed. When we see in His gaze the Father’s eternal plan of love – the salvation of souls – we can remain with this person in his (*her*) suffering for as long as is needed without being crushed or overwhelmed.”

REMINDERS

“Remember, my child, that this is a private prayer. You are not to discuss with the person you pray for nor with anyone else that you pray with me in this for another. Only my son, the priest, is permitted to talk with you about this prayer. Also, remember that if a physical meeting with this person is not always possible, a phone call, letter or other form of communication is fine, but above all, seek a way to be with this person, face-to-face, as often as possible.”
